- OFFER
  Having the right grades and a successful interview means we can give you an offer to study with us.

#### THE APEX EXPERIENCE

- This is where you will have the opportunity to be a student for the day, trying our different A-Level courses, to help you make your final decision.
  - **ENROLMENT**
- Once you have received your GCSE results, you can formally become an APEX student during enrolment, usually taking place on or just after results day.
  - INDUCTION
- Induction will begin in the first week of September—you will receive your official date at enrolment. You can look forward to trips to Universities and other related fairs and events.
