Below is an indication of all the minimum grade requirements for each of our courses. When choosing your first and second choice on the enrolment form, we ask you to choose a course without a level, this is because we will choose the level for you based on the grades that you have achieved.

You can use the grids below to get an idea of what level we will place you on, however please be aware that not all courses have all levels available so try to choose courses that have a level that is suitable for your grades - **choosing courses out of your grade range will slow down the time it takes to process your enrolment.**
